Frequenty Asked Questions:

What is ArtsFest 2015? The downtown festival brings out more than 15,000 people into the heart of Downtown Stuart for fun, food, entertainment, and fine art and amazing crafts from all over the world.

What type of event is ArtsFest 2015? It is a fun and interactive outdoor art festival for people of all ages.

Who may attend? Everyone. This event is open to the general public.

When is the festival? Saturday March 28, 2015 from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Sunday March 29, 2015 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. ArtsFest After Dark is a fun "pop up" art and food event, Friday March 27, 2015 from 7-11pm next to the courthouse cultural center.

Where is the festival located? There are two points of entry to the event this year both located on East Ocean Blvd. The West Gate is locate at Ocean Blvd and Detroit while the East Gate is Ocean and Georgia Ave. Artist will enter the event at Ocean and Florida (access from Osceola and Florida).

What is the cost? General admission is \$5. Tickets may be purchased online prior to the event. (Please visit https://martinartsorg.presencehost.net/news_events/artsfest/event-form/artsfest-tickets/7605/tickets for online ticketing)

Are canned goods accepted toward discounted or free admission into the festival? No. We are not accepting canned goods toward discounted or free admission. You must purchase a ticket for entry into the festival.

Are there military or senior citizen discounts? Unfortunately we are not offering any other discounts.

How do I become a volunteer at the festival? We will start signing up volunteers in January of 2015. If you want us to contact you with volunteer signup updates please sign up for our email newsletter.

Are there any additional costs other than the festival admissions tickets? All stage performances and entertainment are included with admission. A variety of foods and beverages are available for purchase at the festival. Tons of fine art and crafts from 150 juried fine art artists from all over the world are available through individual sales at the artist tents. Parking in downtown Stuart does not generally require payment.

Are there ATMs on site? Yes. ATMs are conveniently located around the festival and outside the gates.

What can I use my credit or debit card to purchase at the festival? Credit or debit cards may be used to purchase festival admissions tickets. You may also use a credit or debit card to purchase beverages, and food (if accepted by independent food vendors).

I ordered my ticket online, how will I RECEIVE my ticket? Online tickets are etickets. Check your email inbox for your Order Confirmation from Eventbrite. Your etickets will be attached to your order confirmation email. Make sure to print and bring them to the event. Or go green and download Eventbrite's mobile app.
